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Why is Levaquin cut to 250mg? There is no geriatric dose and patient's renal function is superb. Isn't resolution of 38k leukocytosis most dependent on antibiotics?  
Why do Kardex & progress notes show Levaquin 500 for 3 more days? Doesn't this order mean it was changed to 250mg upon transfer from ER on day one?  
Physicians Order Forms and medication list show gap in antibiotic coverage for period of March 17 to March 20.  
Pharmacy printout obtained by court order shows 40% of prescribed abx doses were never dispensed by hospital pharmacy.  
High WBC tolerated throughout 17-day hospitalization without infectious disease consult or attention to antibiotics. White count finally jumps to 43k and my father goes into acute respiratory distress.
